professionally in Brazil and Chile before finishing his career in the Australian National League. Roberto is coaching our Premier Youth and Youth Academy. I would also like to welcome Mauro Salamon our goal keeper coach who played semi-professionally in Italy and Valentino Rossoni who played professionally for more than 15 years in Italian 3rd division. Valentino will be involved in clinic style work with individual teams. Of course I welcome back all of last year's coach's including our Director of Coaching for small sided games Joe Amaraddio and our Technical Director Salvo Sottile

To improve coaching across all areas of the club, we are making a sizeable investment in the development of volunteer coaches and already many of our volunteer coaches attended a grass roots training session and a coaching forum which was run by our Technical Director. There are a number of other development initiatives that will occur shortly to ensure that all volunteer coaches have the training required to successfully coach their team and we have setup a coach's reference library for their convenience.

During the off-season we spent money on the returfing of field 12 at Brendale and the construction of an office for our coaching and administrative staff. In the next few months we will need new balls for training, new coaching equipment new goals for small sided games and new playing jerseys which will cost in excess of \$25,000. We will be running a chocolate drive and I encourage every family to at least sell one to two boxes of chocolates to assist in this area. All money raised in the chocolate drive will be used to fund these initiatives, so please as volunteers we are happy to do all of the work that is involved in preparing and running such a large fund raising event, we simply ask that you do your part in selling the chocolates and bringing the money back so that it will benefit your child.

I wish you all a great season and encourage you to get involved with the club in any small way you can. We are all parents, we all have full time jobs, families, commitments, and responsibilities etc. however, without volunteers there is no club and with more volunteers we can collectively improve the experience for our children. 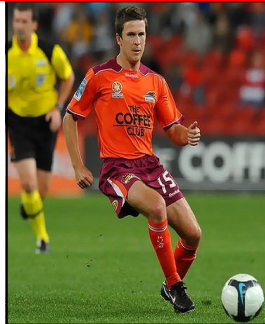
